It is a fact, that we hurt each other on occasion. Sometimes we hurt people and don't even know it. Many times when hurts are allowed to continue, and when someone begins to avoid a person or a group of people, the real reason is not usually given.

The Apostle Paul was discouraged that some Christians in Corinth were not getting along. They were dividing and quarreling and they were jealous with each other. He said they were acting like babies. He described them as "worldly." (I Corinthians 3:1-4)

Jesus said that if a brother sins against you, you are to pout about it and talk to your other friends about that person and above all, shun that brother. **NOT!** Jesus said if a brother sins against you, you are to get upset and go tell the elders and anyone else who will listen but don't dare tell the one that offended you. **NOT.** What does Jesus say? "If your brother sins against you, go and show him his fault, just between the two of you." (Matthew 18:15) If you are unable to follow this principle, please forgive this supposed wrong (GOI = Get over it!) and realize that you have hurt people yourself and you need forgiveness.
